Would you be able to provide any information about an area within Co. Louth, either currently, or formerly, called POLLADURIA?

I have attached transcribed copies of 2 Roman Catholic baptism records, from the parish of Dunleer. Both records show an address of POLLADURIA. I have not been able to find any other reference to that name.

I obtained the attached records from the *rootsireland* database. Both records are for events that occurred in the Dunleer area in the early 1820s.
